

**COMPOST KIDS WAS LAUNCHED IN 2010 AT** THE MARKET HALL IN SHREWSBURY BY SAM POOLEY-STRIDE. FUN **CLASSES WITH A BASIS** IN HISTORY OF ART FOR CHILDREN OF ALL AGES. WE ARE NOT **LOOKING FOR PERFECT BUT ENJOYING THE** EXPERIENCE OF CREATION. 
## A NOTE ABOUT MATERIALS:

# WHERE DID YOU START YOUR CREATIVE JOURNEY?

AS A CHILD I LOVED TO DRAW SWANS AND WILLOW TREES. THIS FEELS LIKE A DISTANT **MEMORY I CAN SEE MYSELF REPEATING WHEN** I'M OLD. IN A CHAIR **BUT THE RIVER WITH A** BLANKET OVER MY LAP AND LOTS OF SNACKS !!!. MY MUM WASN'T ALLOWED TO GO TO ART SCHOOL **DESPITE THE TEACHERS** VISITING HER HOME AND **BEGGING HER PARENTS TO** LET HER GO SO I SUSPECT SHE PROJECTED HER **CREATIVE ENERGY ONTO** ME.

# DESCRIBE YOUR PROCESS/ PROCESSES.

IF I OVER THINK MY IDEAS
THEY BECOME HEAVY AND
LABOURED SO ONCE I HAVE
A NEW CONCEPT I PIN IT
TO MY CORK BOARD WALL.
IF IT'S STILL CALLING TO

ME A WEEK OR MONTH
LATER I CAN APPROACH
IT WITH LESS INTENSITY,
THEN IT STAYS LIGHT
HEARTED AND FLUID. I LIKE
TO THINK OF PROJECTS AS
FRIENDS I CAN GO TO AT
ANY TIME. WORKING WITH
THEM BRINGS COMFORT
AND STRUCTURE IN A
UNPREDICTABLE LIFESTYLE
OF SELF EMPLOYMENT.

# DO YOU USE A SKETCHBOOK OR JOURNAL?

NOT RELIGIOUSLY BUT I HAVE ALWAYS HAD ONE THROUGHOUT MY LIFE. I RECENTLY FOUND ONE WITH SKETCHES OF THE PEOPLE I WORKED WITH AT MOSS BROS HEAD OFFICE. WHEN I WAS A **MENSWEAR DESIGNER** FOR BLAZER IN THE LATE 90'S. I HAD DRAWN THE RECEPTIONIST AND THE MERCHANDISER. I LIKE TO USE A SKETCHBOOK MOST WHEN I'M CREATIVELY FRUSTRATED. IT HELPS TO KEEP DRAWING. IT ALSO HELPS TO ANCHOR A MOMENT, MY CLEAREST MEMORIES ARE THE ONES I'VE SKETCHED.

# WHO IS YOUR FAVOURITE ARTIST LIVING OR DEAD?

PICASSO. I HAD AN **AMAZING FEW DAYS IN BARCELONA. I SPENT** A DAY ON MY OWN **WONDERING AROUND THE** PICASSO GALLERY. HE HAS A VARIETY OF STYLES FROM HIS CERAMIC **BIRD THROUGH SELF** PORTRAITS. TO QUOTE JACKSON POLLOCK "HE'S **DONE EVERYTHING". I FELT EMOTIONAL TO SEE HE** WAS VERY SKILLED AT **CLASSICAL PAINTINGS** FROM A YOUNG AGE AND ALTHOUGH HE IS RECOGNISED FOR HIS **DECONSTRUCTED WORK** HE WAS ABLE TO DRAW A LIKENESS IF HE CHOSE TO. THIS HIT A NERVE WITH ME BECAUSE MY **POP ART STYLE GRAPHIC ILLUSTRATIONS CAN ECLIPSE THE FACT THAT** I AM ALSO A SKILLED ARTIST, PEOPLE OFTEN **ASSUME YOU HAVE TO** BE A SERIOUS TO BE A RESPECTED ARTIST. HE HAD ALSO HAD MANY **DIFFERENT STYLES. AS ARTISTS WE OFTEN FEEL** WE HAVE TO BE CLEAR **ABOUT OUR STYLE BUT NOTHING STAYS THE** SAME SO WHY SHOULD **WE. PLAYING WITH ART** HAS BEEN THE MOST REWARDING FOR ME.

# WHAT'S YOUR FAVOURITE PIECE OF ART?

I WANT TO SAY THE **FOUNTAIN BY MARCEL DUCHAM BECAUSE IT REMINDS US ALL THAT ART** IS VERY SUBJECTIVE AND **NOT TO TAKE OURSELVES** TOO SERIOUSLY. I AM DRAWN TO EGON SCHIELE'S PAINTINGS OF PEOPLE. HE CAPTURED THE PERSONALITIES SO WELL. HE HAD A STRONG GRASP OF LINE AND FORM. HIS STROKES **EXPRESS MOVEMENT** WHILE ENCASED IN THE STRUCTURE OF HIS LINES. HE HAD AN INTERESTING WAY OF PROJECTING THE FORM BY ADDING WHITE PAINT AROUND THE LINES. I WONDER WHAT ELSE HE **WOULD HAVE GONE ON** TO CREATE IF HE HADN'T DIED SO YOUNG, EGON SCHIELE. SEATED WOMAN WITH BENT KNEE, 1917I'M ALSO SPLASH ARE DEVINE. THE MOVEMENT AGAINST THE GRAPHIC STYLE BACKDROP IS SOMETHING I ASPIRED TO WHEN I BEGAN **WORKING DIGITALLY BACK** IN THE LATE 90'S.

FOND OF DAVID HOCKNEY'S PORTRAITS & PEOPLE BUT THERE ARE TOO MANY TO CHOOSE FROM. HE HAS A WAY OF CAPTURING THE REALITY OF PEOPLE. AN **EVERYDAY FONDNESS AND** HE DOESN'T SHY AWAY FROM BOLD COLOURS, NOW YOU GOT ME STARTED I CAN'T RESIST ADDING THAT THE COLOURS IN **BIGGER SPLASH ARE DEVINE. THE MOVEMENT AGAINST THE GRAPHIC** STYLE BACKDROP IS SOMETHING I ASPIRED TO WHEN I BEGAN WORKING **DIGITALLY BACK IN THE LATE 90'S.** 

# ADVICE FOR A YOUNG YOU?

CHILL OUT. TRYING SO HARD WON'T GET YOU ANYWHERE NEW. KEEP HAVING FUN WITH ART ...LIKE YOU DID AS A KID IN YOUR BEDROOM. MISTAKES ARE OK AND YOU CAN WORK WITH THEM TO MAKE SOMETHING BETTER SO DON'T BE AFFRAID.





THIS IS A GREAT THING TO DO EVEN WITH YOUR LITTLE ONES, TAKE PAPER AND PENS WITH YOU ON A PICNIC, TO THE PARK AND JUST GET THEM TO DRAW WHAT THEY SEE. IT'S NOT JUST ABOUT THE PICTURES, IT'S ALSO A GREAT WAY TO START A DISCUSSION OR EVEN THE BEGINNING OF A STORY.

TAKING PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE SCENES YOU ARE DRAWING CAN BE USED AT A LATER DATE. CHERIE, HAS OFTEN PHOTOSHOPS PART OF THESE PICTURES INTO HER SKETCHING, WHY NOT TRY THIS USING A PRINT OF ONE OF YOUR PICTURES, CUT UP PARTS OF IT AND THEN STICK IT OVER YOUR DRAWINGS, THESE COLLAGES WILL ADD SOME GRAPHIC COOL TO YOUR SKETCH BOOKS.

#### STEPS

LIVE SKETCHING IS DOING EXACTLY THAT!
TAKING YOUR SKETCHBOOK OUT AND
ABOUT AND DRAWING WHAT YOU SEE.
USING PENCIL OR A BIRO IS A GREAT PLACE
TO START.


AS THE SPACE AND THINGS IN IT CHANGE, KEEP DRAWING THEM, THE IDEA IS FOR IT TO FLOW, FOR IT TO BE MANY MOMENTS IN TIME, NOT JUST ONE. TO GIVE YOUR SKETCHES SHADE AND COLOUR YOU CAN USE WHATEVER MEDIUM YOU HAVE TO HAND. YOU COULD TAKE A SMALL WATERCOLOUR BOX WITH YOU, OR JUST USE WATER ONTO THE BLACK INK OF A BIRO, OR USE SOME CHARCOAL. CHERIE HAS USED COFFEE AT COFFEESHOPS, TEA AND EVEN THE MAKEUP FROM HER BAG.

## MAKE 3

## RAINBOW & CLOUD HANGINGS

#### WHAT YOU NEED

- RAINBOW AND CLOUD
- **ITEMPLATE**
- **WHITE CARD**
- **# COLOURED CARD OR**
- **COLOURED PENCILS.**
- **PAINTS OR PENS**
- HOLE PUNCH
- COLOURED STRINGS OR WOOL

#### THE RAINBOW

CUT THE RAINBOW SHAPE OUT ONTO RED CARD

CUT OUT EACH SECTION OF RAINBOW IN A DIFFERENT COLOUR CARD

STICK THE RAINBOW ONTO THE RED CARD IN ORDER

HOLE PUNCH ALONG THE BOTTOM OF THE RAINBOW

CUT THREADS INTO LENGTHS OF 30CM FOLD THREE SETS OF THREADS IN HALF, FEED THROUGH THE HOLE AND LOOP BACK TO MAKE TASSELS




2. TRY USING BEADS AT THE END OF THE STRING TO GIVE SOME EXTRA BLING!


3. TRY AN OMBRE EFFECT USING LOTS OF DIFFERENT SHADES OF THE SAME COLOUR.



#### THE CLOUD

PRINT OUT THE CLOUD TEMPLATE ONTO WHITE CARD
HOLE PUNCH ALONG THE BOTTOM OF THE CLOUD
CHOOSE DIFFERENT COLOUR THREADS
AND CUT INTO LENGTHS OF 30CM
FOLD THREE SETS OF THREADS IN HALF,
FEED THROUGHT THE HOLE AND LOOP
BACK TO MAKE TASSELS.









### AWESOME ANIMAL PORTRAITS

#### WHAT YOU NEED


- **PENCIL**
- **#FELT TIP PENS**
- **CUSTOMISE TEMPLATE**
- **SCISSORS AND GLUE**



#### STEPS

CHERIE ILLUSTRATES AWESOME
ANIMALS THAT SHE MEETS, BUT
IT'S THE CHARACTERS THAT REALLY
SHINE THROUGH. COME UP WITH THE
PERSONALITY OF YOUR ANIMAL, IF YOU
DON'T HAVE YOUR OWN PET THEN USE
YOUR IMAGINATION. THEN PRINT OUT
OUR CUSTOMISE TEMPLATE, COLOUR IN
THE HATS, GLASSES AND BADGES AND
STICK THEM ON.

FOR THOSE LITTLE ONES, PRINT OUT DOGGY DUDE ABOVE AND THEN GET THOSE LITTLE FINGERS TO CUT OUT THE ACCESSORIES, IT'S GOOD FOR THE MOTOR SKILLS. THEN USE THE ACCESSORIES AND STICK THOSE ON TO HIM.






## MAKE 5

## MIXED MEDIA PORTRAITS

PORTRAITURE CAN BE A
LITTLE SCARY TO MASTER,
BUT REALLY ITS ALL
ABOUT PRACTICE. IF YOU
ARE NERVOUS TO START,
WHY NOT USE A MIRROR
AND DRAW YOURSELF.
STARTING WITH VERY
QUICK SKETCHES, TIMING
YOURSELF WITH A STOP
WATCH AND BUILDING UP TO
MORE DETAIL WILL HELP YOU
LOSE THE NERVES.



#### STEPS

START WITH A DOING TWO 1 MINUTE SKETCHES, GETTING FAMILIAR WITH THE DIFFERENT PARTS OF YOUR FACE AND THEN 5 MINUTES, THEN 10 MINUTES. EACH TIME YOU CAN ADD MORE DETAILS. IT DOESN'T MATTER WHAT YOU USE, A PENCIL, A PEN, AN IPAD (ONE OF CHERIE'S FAVOURITE WAYS TO DRAW). USE WASHES OVER THE FACE TO ADD SHADE.

FOR THE LITTLE ONES GET SOME MAGAZINES OR NEWSPAPERS AND CUT OUT LOTS OF FACE PARTS, EYES, NOSES, MOUTHS AND EARS AND GET THE LITTLE ONES TO MAKE UP FUNNY FACES WITH THE PARTS. IT WILL HELP THEM LEARN WHERE THE PIECES OF THE FACES GO AND THEN YOU CAN ASK THEM TO PAINT OR DRAW IN THE HAIR.

USING OLD PAPERS, THE INSIDE OF ENVELOPES, AN OLD PAINTING THAT DIDN'T WORK AND DRAWING SUBJECTS OVER THEM CAN BE REALLY EFFECTIVE, WE KEEP A STACK OF THESE KIND OF SURFACES READY FOR A DRAWING SESSION. THEN PASTE THEM ALL INTO YOUR SKETCH BOOK. DOCUMENTING YOUR JOURNEY IS SUCH AN IMPORTANT PART OF IT ALL AND YOU WILL BE SURPRISED AT HOW THE MISTAKES CAN SOMETIMES TURN INTO YOUR BEST WORK.
